

## Tourism on iBiza

iBiza has a reputation for being a party island. The nightlife is centered around two areas iBiza Town on the Eastern shore and San Antonio on the West.

iBiza clubs have become the center of the worldwide dance music. The season traditionally begins at the start of June with the clubs opening parties and finishes on the first weekend of October with the Closing Parties. There are plans to extend this season but it's a complicated situation involving hotels and airlines.
